ALADDIN CONNECT APP



We require at least one parent to download and use the Aladdin Connect App. This will be the main form of communication that the school will be using. The cost of sending messages to families, through the app, is free for the school. The cost of sending text messages has steadily increased and it is now becoming very costly. If you haven't already downloaded the app or need help with it, please contact the office and help will be given.

School Attendance

Pupils must arrive at school for **8.50 a.m**. each morning. For health and safety reasons, **the back and side gates will be closed at 9:15am**. After this time pupils must enter the school through the front reception. If a pupil will be arriving to school late we ask that parents/guardians inform the school beforehand so that their attendance can be recorded properly.

The school is obliged to communicate with The Child & Family Agency (Tusla) with regard to pupils' attendance at school and to report all absences in excess of 20 days. You will receive an automated courtesy text from the school advising if your child has missed 15/20/25 etc. days from school.

PARENT/TEACHER MEETINGS



Face to face Parent/Teacher meetings are due to take place on Monday, the 24th and Tuesday, the 25th of October. The meetings will take place between 2.30 - 5.00 pm each afternoon. School will finish at 2:15pm on both days.

We will be using the Parent Teacher Booking system on Aladdin Connect for the scheduling of appointments. As previously mentioned please ensure that you have downloaded and have access to Aladdin Connect. Time slots will be released to parents in the coming weeks. Parents/Guardians will access the time slots on their Aladdin Connect App and can choose the available appointment which best suits them. Booking of a suitable time is only available through Aladdin Connect. Please contact the office if you need any help downloading or operating the app.

SECONDARY SCHOOL APPLICATIONS



Representatives from the different local secondary schools have been speaking to our pupils about transitioning to secondary school. We advise parents of pupils in 6th class on the importance of enrolling their child in their preferred school by the correct date. SCHOOL UNIFORM


Your child should wear his/her school uniform daily. The class teacher will advise the children about their "P.E. Day" when children may wear the school tracksuit.
