## KIVA

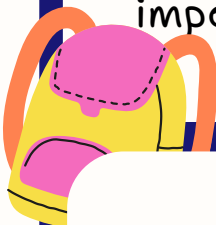
As part of our ongoing commitment to promoting a safe and inclusive school environment, Kiva surveys will be taking place before the end of the school year.
