### Drop Off & Pick Up Arrangements for Academic Year 24/25

Parents of pupils in Junior & Senior Infants may only accompany their child to and from their classrooms. Please note pupils from 1st – 6th classes may not be accompanied on to the school grounds unless prior approval has been granted. Additional staff will be placed on supervision duties for the first two weeks to support our 1<sup>st</sup> class pupils as they enter/exit the school grounds.
