



Dear Parents,

It is almost 25 years since the introduction of the previous mathematics curriculum, so a change is not only due, but welcomed.

There are many new understandings underpinning the teaching and learning of mathematics, and new approaches and pedagogies must be embraced, to help prepare our students for the ways of thinking, working and problem solving required by future life and work.

The New Primary Maths Curriculum (NPMC) provides an emphasis on creativity, playful approaches to learning, problem solving and links to real life experiences of our students.

The 'how' our students learn is now seen as important as the 'what', with a focus on process and not product.

The NPMC was introduced in all primary schools and special schools in September 2023, and schools and teachers will continue to become more familiar with it during this academic year (2024 - 2025), working towards implementation.

There will be a full school day closure for staff training on April 28th 2025.
